#### LIGHTING THE ADVENT CANDLES

Come and gather, O People of God!

We light the candle of love to remind us that God is love, that God's love was revealed fully through Jesus, and that we ought to love one another as God loves us so much.

**Our Lord has come. Jesus is LOVE.** (*Light the fourth candle*)
