In keeping with the donor's wishes, we support the causes that serve the needs of Lodi and its surrounding communities. We afford special emphasis to projects that lead to building a more welcoming community and that strengthen self-sufficiency in the charitable sector.

#### *Areas of Interest*

- Our **community development** grantmaking revolves primarily around objectives to enhance the quality of life in Lodi and its surrounding communities. We support efforts that help people, especially the vulnerable and marginalized, live a life of dignity and equality as their voice and presence are honored.
- Our **congregation missional vitality** grantmaking aims to deepen and enrich the religious lives of the residents in the area. We believe that relevant and missional congregations seek for creativeness and inclusiveness through their programs.
- Besides grantmaking in our two principal areas, we award scholarships to individuals who seek postsecondary education and training. #### *Application Process*

- If you believe your organization/congregation has a request that fits within our guidelines, complete the application form and attach a one-page narrative answering the questions listed.
- We may accept applications from individuals, but it may be exceptional for need-based scholarship and pioneering initiatives.
- Grants will be awarded with the approval of the Lodi UMC Church Council at its April and October/November meetings. Thus, completed applications shall be submitted no later than March 31 and October 15 for the appropriate committee's review.
