Sizes Small to XL (mostly med/large)

- Unbranded
- Male and female

Pants

- Long pants
- Unbranded
- Male and female

Socks

- Male and female
- Kids socks can be fun colors
- Cotton

Shoes

- Flip flops and sandals (great need)
- All sizes
- Closed toed shoes

Underwear

- Cotton only
- All sizes (great need for men's sizes)

Other needed items:

- Fall jackets, gently used, laundered (all sizes)
- Blankets/ Quilts, gently used, laundered
- Duffle bags/ laundry bags
